Delores and Mort (Marvin) Moyer

Friends to a Wonderful Lifetime Together



Mort and Delores grew up in Dodgeville, with Mort being four years older. He was a supportive big brother to Delores, giving her rides to high school and advice about life and dating. They started dating when Delores was a senior, and Mort went on to serve in the army. They got engaged while Delores was in nursing school and married after her graduation.

Mort attended UW Platteville and later worked at the Post Office in Dodgeville while coaching basketball at St. Joseph's Grade School. Delores worked as a night supervisor at St. Joseph's hospital. After Mort's high school basketball coach passed away, he decided to return to school. Delores became the Director of Nursing at the public hospital in Dodgeville until Mort graduated from UW Platteville with a degree in Health and Coaching.

Upon graduation, Mort took his first high school coaching position in Benton, WI, where he achieved several conference championships and was named "Most Outstanding Conference Coach." Over the next 45 years, he coached at various schools, including Orangeville, Freeport Aquin High School, Lanark, and Freeport, achieving numerous conference championships and regional wins. He coached notable athletes like Jamal Meeks, Michael Flowers, and Jonte Flowers, who went on to play professional basketball. Mort received many awards, including induction into the Dodgeville Athletic Hall of Fame.

Mort and Delores have two grown sons. Jonathan, who played college basketball and graduated from Washington University in Missouri, is now the CEO and owner of Bay Harbor with Delores. Joel graduated from UW Illinois with a degree in Healthcare Administration and owns a healthcare management company. They have six grandchildren and one great-granddaughter.

Delores worked in various nursing positions, including as a Nurse Practitioner for 20 years, while the family moved for Mort's coaching career. In 1987, she founded Bay Harbor Assisted Living, which cares for people with advanced dementia. She continues to work part-time, teaching and conducting quality assurance programs. The company has received numerous awards for its innovative programs.

Mort and Delores spent the last 25 years living at Bishops Bay, enjoying golf and Packer parties. Delores remains active in her long-standing book club. In May 2023, they moved to Cardinal View, where they have found a supportive and caring community.

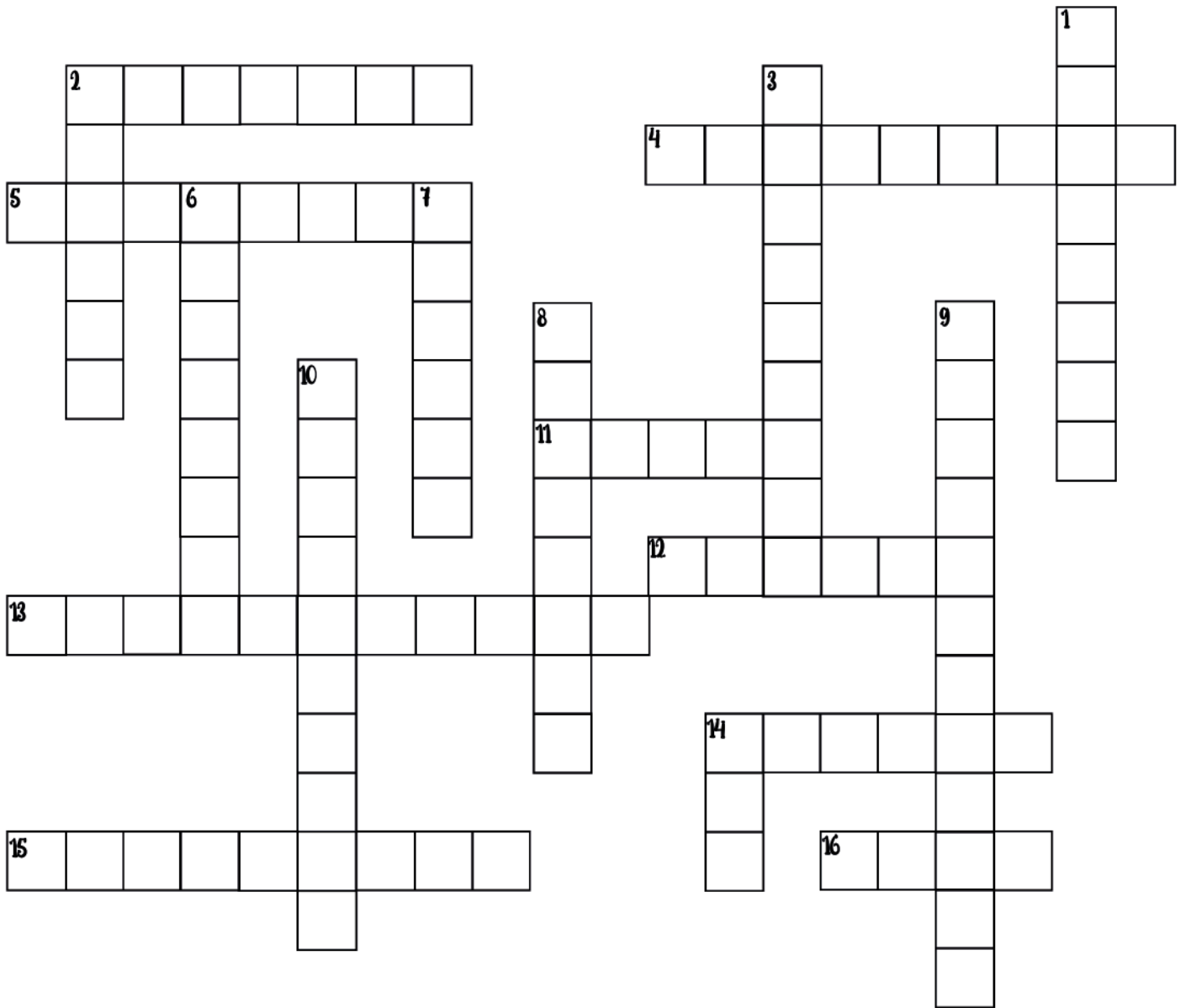
