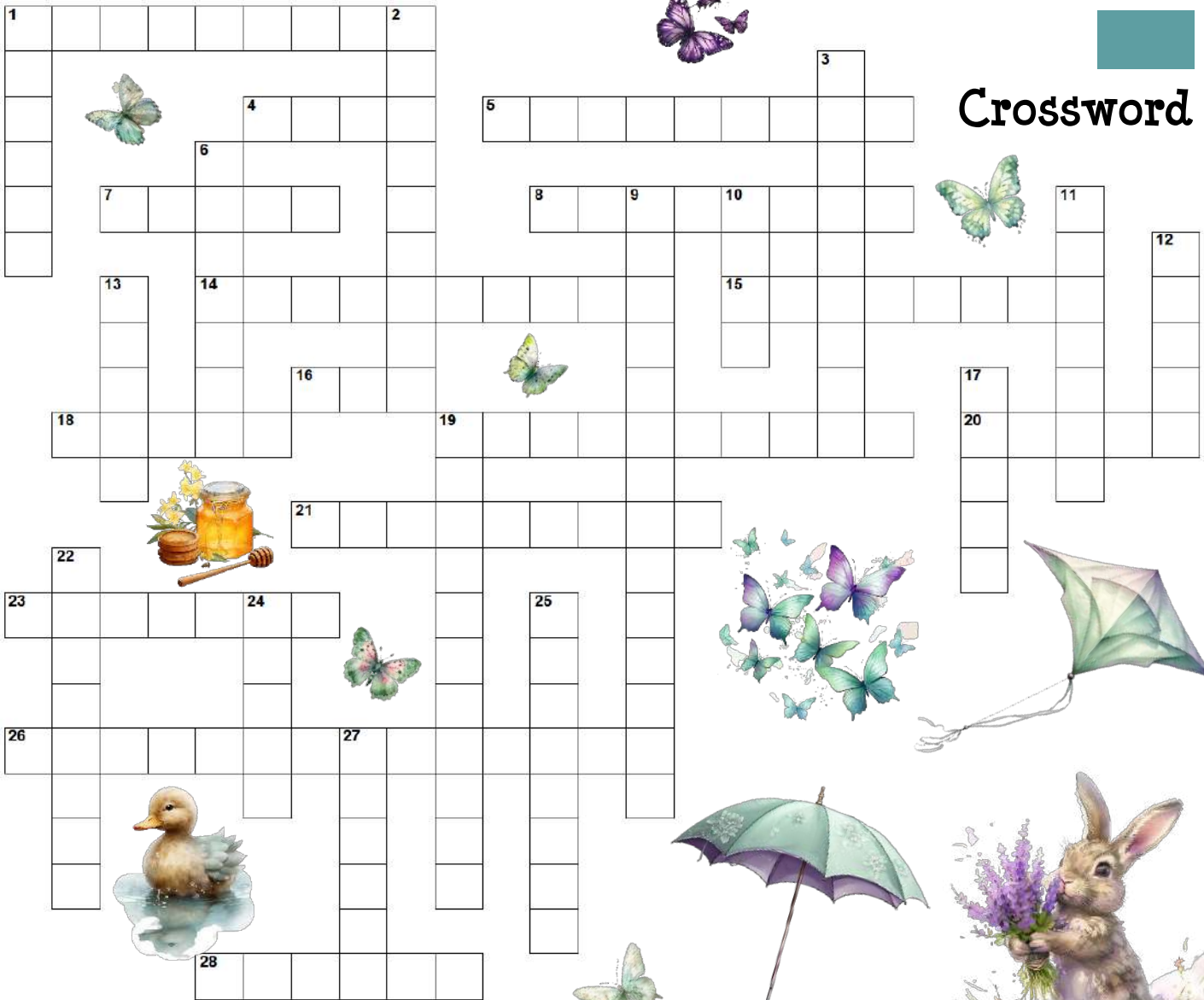
“Good humor and laughter are far too wonderful not to come straight from the heart of God.” – Beth Moore

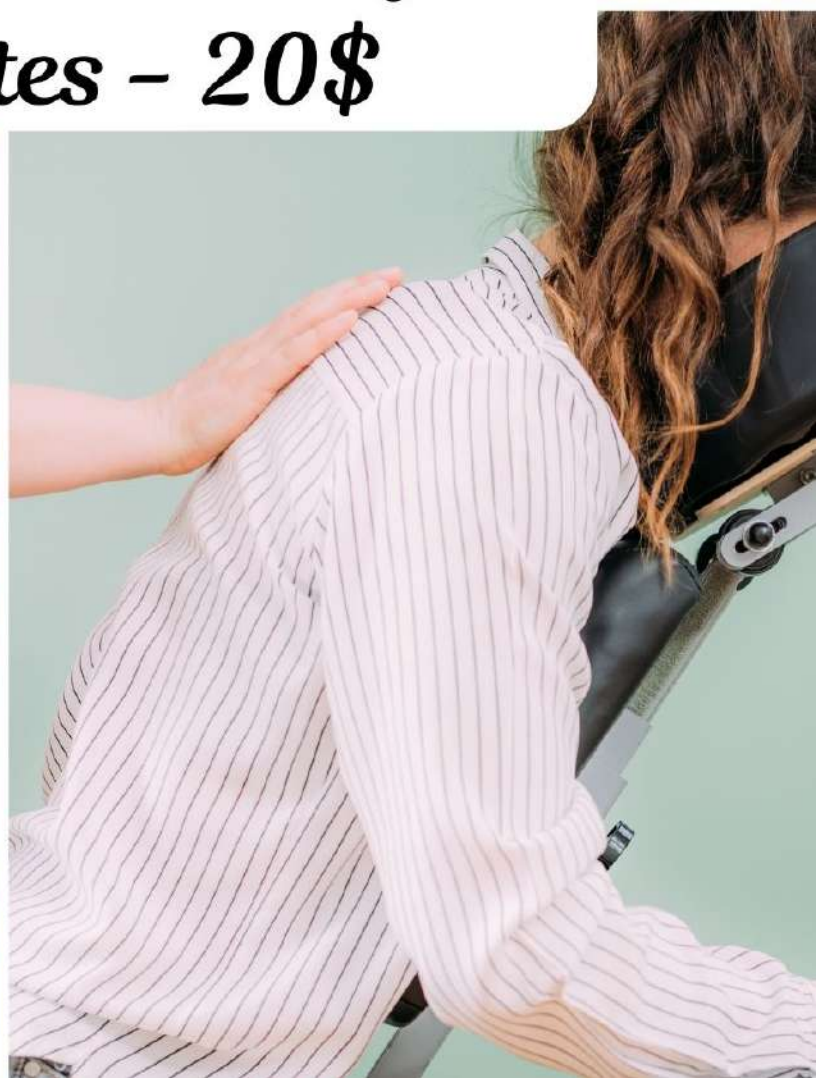
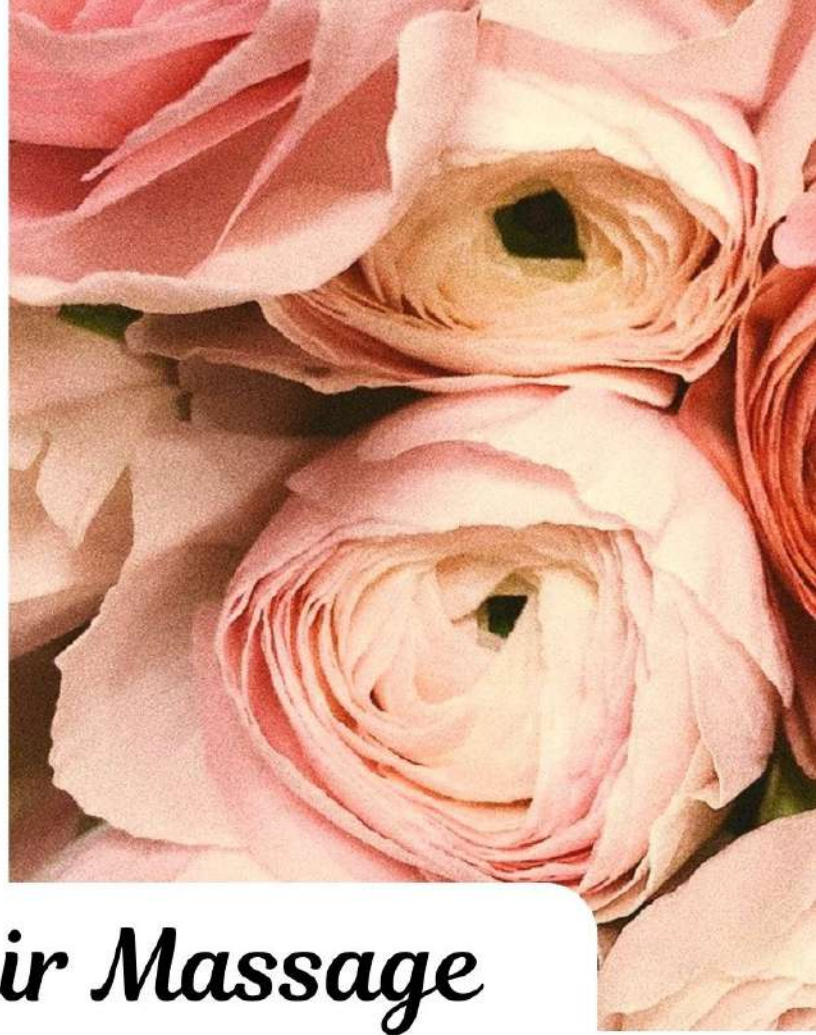
